




Map of Meeting Venues

4. TRANSPORTATION

4.1 Airport – Hotel Transportation

Transportation by taxi in Bangkok is metered and readily available. At Suvarnabhumi Airport, designated taxi queues are located in the arrival halls. You may wish take the taxi available at the airport to the hotel. Estimated price by taxi from airport to hotel is approximately 500-700 THB. Please note that surcharges do apply during peak hours or late hours and can be up to 50% of the metered fare. Please request for the receipt from the taxi driver before payment if you require one. All taxis accept cash.

Please note that transportation will not be provided for delegations between the airport and the hotel.

4.2 Transportation for Cultural Tour, Welcome Dinner for APSN Forum held on Tuesday (24th October 2023)

Transportation will be provided for delegates after the Forum from Chatrium Hotel Riverside Bangkok to the venue for the Cultural Tour. After the Cultural Tour, transport will be arranged for delegates for the Welcome Dinner for APSN Forum hosted by Port Authority of Thailand on 24th October 2023. Afterwards, delegates will be sent back to Chatrium Hotel Riverside Bangkok, two-way transportation will be provided for delegates going for the Welcome Dinner.

4.3 Transportation for Farewell Dinner for APSN Forum held on Wednesday (25th October 2023)

5. GENERAL INFORMATION

5.1 BANGKOK, THAILAND

Bangkok (or Krung Thep) is the capital and largest city of Thailand. It is the No. 1 destination cities in 2019 published by Mastercard with magnificent temples and palaces, authentic canals, markets and a vibrant nightlife. 5.2 CULTURAL TOUR: Wat Arunratchawararam (or Arunratchawararam Temple)

This monastery is well known in English as the Temple of Dawn. Once it was generally called Wat Chaeng that means "The Temple of Dawn"; This name is referred to the one that was given by King Taksin.





5.3 CULTURAL TOUR: Thonburi Palace

PhraRacha Wang Derm (Wang Derm Palace) or Thon Buri Palace is the royal palace of King Taksin the Great. Wang DermPalace or Thon Buri Palace was built in the reign of King Taksin the great in 1767, during the same time thatThonburi was appointed the new capital city of Thailand. The palace was built to be the royal residence with a Throne Hall for governing.







5.3 WEATHER

The Climate of the Thailand is tropical. It is characterized by relatively high temperature, high humidity and abundant rainfall. The average temperature in Bangkok in October is 33°C/25°C.

5.4 TIME

The Thailand's Time is consistent with UTC/GMT +7 hours

5.5 CURRENCIES

Thailand' unit of currency is the Thailand Baht (THB). Major foreign currencies are exchangeable at banks.

5.6 CREDIT CARDS AND ATMS

Visa, MasterCard, American Express, JCB and other major international credit cards are accepted at most establishments or can be used to retrieve cash from ATMs throughout the City, although some small shops and restaurants may only accept cash payments.

5.7 ELECTRICITY and WATER SUPPLY

Electrical outlets in Thailand are charged to 220v at 50 cycles per second, which is compatible with appliances from the U.K. but not those from the US and many other economies. While most computer cables have adaptors for voltage, visitors from the U.S. and those not on the 220/50 v. will have to bring adapters to run most other appliances. Outlets in Thailand generally feature flat, two-pronged plugs, though some feature holes for round plug ends. Few outlets feature three holes (grounded outlets) so it is often necessary to have a three to two prong adapter for using notebook computers in Thailand.

Though tap water in Bangkok is technically safe to drink, the plumbing in certain buildings may make water inadvisable to ingest. Furthermore, travelers' unaccustomed to otherwise harmless bacteria in the water could get upset stomachs from drinking ice that is technically 'safe' to consume. Bottled water in Thailand is recommended as it is cheap and ubiquitous and most ice is safe to consume as it is produced with potable water, with cube ice generally safer than crushed ice.

5.8 TELECOMMUNICATION SERVICES

Local phone services are reliable and readily available at hotels. While sim cards for mobile phones can be bought at convenience store and these are the major telecommunication service providers in Thailand:

5.9 TIPS

Tipping in Bangkok is not customary but encouraged when you experience good service. This would be above the standard 10% gratuity added to your bill by some restaurants and hotels.
